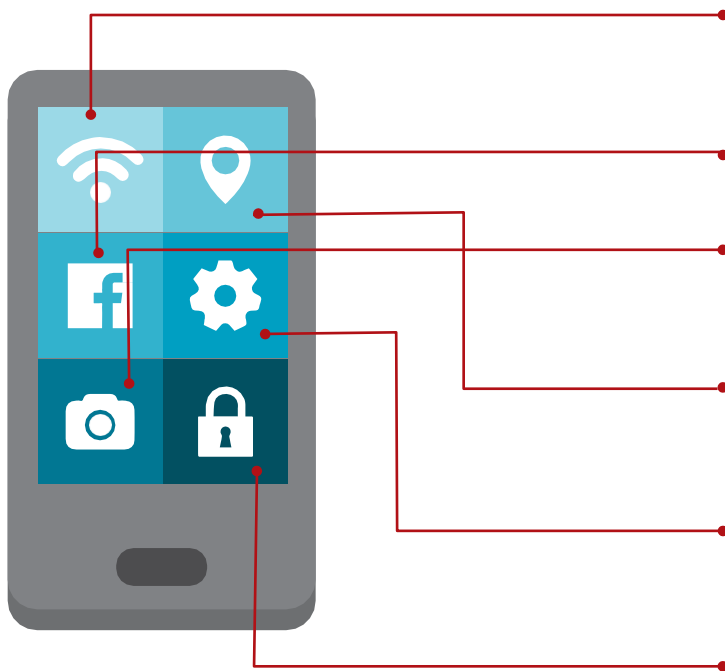


## Be Online

- Respect other's privacy, ask for their permission before you tag or share an image of them online
- Use "ghost mode" and "location settings" wisely
- Never share passwords, change them often
- Use privacy settings & Multi Factor Authentication.

## Be Kind Online

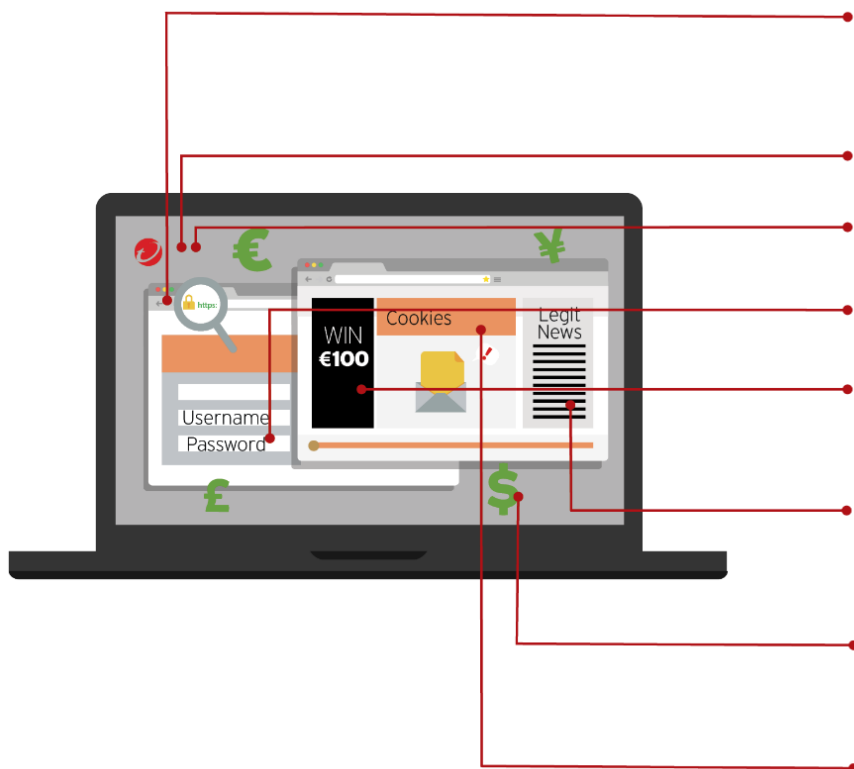
- ✓ If you are having a difficult time online, talk to someone you trust
- ✓ If you are giving someone else a hard time online, apologize - that takes courage
- ✓ Be kind to others online because it's the right thing to do and it reflects on you

## Be Savvy Online

Before you choose to believe what you read/see or share online, ask yourself the following:

- ✓ Why was this made?
- ✓ Who made it?
- ✓ What's missing?
- ✓ How might different people interpret it?
- ✓ How do I know this is true? Check multiple sites & Fact Check on Google
- ✓ Who might benefit from this?
- ✓ Who might be harmed by this?

## Be Safe Online



Only use sites with **Https://**  
stick to sites you know and trust

Protect devices - use anti-malware

Keep anti-malware up to date

Use strong passwords, Password Manager

Always be suspicious. If it sounds too good to be true - don't click; Research instead.

Double check your sources on multiple sites—question everything

Cookies track your behavior to 'enhance your experience'. Be informed, research online.
